### Town Centre Access Plan: Ongoing Construction Works

As you may be aware, highway works associated with the Town Centre Access Plan (TCAP) are ongoing at various locations to improve access to Stockport town centre for all users.

With the Easter holidays approaching we ask you to remind your pupils to minimise risk to themselves, other residents and road workers, in particular when near a construction site, by considering/observing the following:

- One should never enter a construction site unauthorised, or without training and the correct protective clothing;
- Always read and obey safety signs;
- Beware of uneven ground where construction works are taking place;
- In the event of finding exposed cabling where construction works are taking place, this should not be touched as doing so could result in electrocution;
- Site machinery and tools are only to be operated by trained professionals as they can be very dangerous; and
- Construction sites/works look exciting and fun but they can be very dangerous places. Workers driving along could miss somebody wandering into the area and a large vehicle poses extreme danger.
