## YEAR 4 VISIT TO BLACKPOOL ZOO Thursday 14th July 2022

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our science topic on living things and habitats, we have arranged for Year 4 to go on a learning visit to Blackpool Zoo on Thursday 14th July. Whether big, small, fierce, friendly, cute, creepy, or just plain, adorable, animals never cease to fascinate us. We can learn so much from them, but it's such a lot of fun that we don't even realise we're learning. The children will be able to discover all the animals the zoo has and they may even find some they might not even knew existed.

The children will have an opportunity to meet the sea lions ranger and watch the sea lion show. They will get to see the penguin beach to explore life in the ocean and learn more about beaks, feet, feathers and wings. If we have fans of wolves, and they have ever wondered what wolves and wallabies eat, the Wolf Ridge and Wallaby Walkabout has lots of interesting facts about their teeth and diet. No visit to the zoo would be complete without a trip to the Orangutan Outlook to hear stories of the rainforest, great apes.

Please make sure that your child wears their school uniform and some comfortable shoes (trainers are allowed) as they will be on their feet for most of the visit. They should also bring with them a waterproof jacket on the day if rain is forecast and a sunhat.
