## Please help us to keep your community safe by:

- Only attending organised bonfire/firework events
- Reporting unofficial bonfires on public land
- Calling us to safely dispose of unwanted fireworks
- Follow the firework safety code (BELOW)

## Firework safety code:

- Buy fireworks marked BS 7114 or CE
- Keep fireworks in a closed metal box and use them one at a time
- Read and follow the instructions on each firework
- Light the firework at arm's length with a taper and stand well back
- Keep naked flames, including cigarettes, away from fireworks • Keep pets indoors

- Never return to a firework once it has been lit
- Never put fireworks in pockets or throw them
- Light sparklers one at a time and wear gloves
- Keep a bucket of water nearby at all times
- Alcohol and fireworks do not mix and may lead to injury
