Feelings and emotions (on-going)

• Check in – how are you feeling today? (and at regular points throughout the day)



- Talk about characters and their feelings when sharing books. Encourage your child to look carefully at the expressions in the pictures
- Enjoy sharing 'Aaargh Spider! story. Link sent via Class Dojo
- Encourage your child to use voice sounds and make sound effects when sharing the book 'Trick or Treat' on Class Dojo

Early reading and pre-phonics (Phase I):

- Where's my name? (it could be hidden in a different place now and then)
- Book time child to look at a book, talk about what is happening in the pictures, say what might happen next or give an alternative ending
- Nursery rhymes practise well-known favourites, fill in the missing words, make up own versions
- Send a message and/ or photo via Class Dojo of a book you are really enjoying at the moment ©

These can be encouraged and supported throughout the day, e.g. you could practise nursery rhymes at 'bath time', share a bedtime story, spot the first letter of your child's name in books, magazines or comics or go on a sound hunt.

• Please remember to make sure your child sees their name written like this 'Name' not 'NAME'





Child-initiated play and learning time

- Drawing, painting, jigsaws, baking, board games, playdough, block play, small world imaginative play, e.g. dinosaur, trains etc.
- Enable your child to have time to play independently as well as alongside you.
- Comment on what they are doing and encourage them to describe and explain what they are doing, is happening...

Children usually develop high levels of engagement when involved in play linked to their own interests and fascinations and become more deeply involved, thinking creatively and solving problems. This time being made available and opportunities to experience multi-sensory contexts for learning is really important for the development of language, communication, social, emotional and play skills.

- Counting during play and everyday activities, e.g. counting steps, toys, food items and when baking
- Number hunt around the house
- Topmarks Maths game, e.g. Underwater Counting (up to 5) https://www.topmarks.co.uk/learning-tocount/underwater-counting

Shape, space and measures:

• Play 'Where is...?' with your favourite toy. An adult could out it in different positions, e.g. under the table, on the chair, next to the toy box and behind the cupboard. Can your child find it and tell you where it is e.g. under..., behind...?

Creative

- Create your own spider (Aargh Spider!)
- Make a magic wand using a stick and some ribbon or coloured paper

In class this week, we will be making spooky spells and making marks, e.g. a list of contents and deciding what the magic does, e.g. makes you smaller/ disappear, changes you into a frog! Adult could scribe and child make marks for own writing.
